Skills development | UNICEF Despite evidence demonstrating how central girls ' education is to development, gender disparities in education persist. Around the world, 132 million girls are out of school, including 34.3 million of primary school age, 30 million of lower-secondary school age, and 67.4 million of upper-secondary school age.

Girls' education | UNICEF UNICEF ' s key programmatic interventions centers on improving access and quality of education through school rehabilitation (in addition to provision of pre-fabricated classrooms), teacher training, provision of accelerated learning programmes such as Curriculum B that enables children who have missed out on years of education to catch up to their peers and re-integrate into the formal education system.

Education | UNICEF Syrian Arab Republic UNICEF has developed a series of standardized kits to support activities related to children ' s health, education and protection. These include supplies for water, hygiene and sanitation (WASH), early childhood development and education in different contexts. Some kits also address the needs of families and women in under-resourced situations.

Despite the challenges faced, UNICEF along with its partners in the field succeeded to facilitate access to education for 204,340 children (49.7 per cent girls), through major rehabilitation of 18 affected schools and rehabilitation of latrines in 218 schools (thereby reaching 32 per cent of the target).
