The object of a sentence (if there is one) normally comes after the verb phrase.

Whether there is an object or not depends on the meaning of the verb.

For example, if you want to talk about what someone is doing, you might say ' She is writing ' but if you want to talk

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about the point of the activity, you might say, ‘ She is writing a book ’ .

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Grammar rules – If

the reporting clause is before the direct speech: We write a comma (,) before the direct speech. We write the exact words inside the inverted commas. The first letter is a capital letter. We write a full stop (.) before the closing inverted commas.
