Harmonised EU rules are in place covering a range of animal species and welfare-affecting issues. Whilst Council Directive 98/58/EC lays down the minimum standards for the protection of all farmed animals, specific directives are addressed at the protection of individual animals. EU legislation also sets welfare standards for their transport and conditions at the time of stunning and slaughter.

Animal welfare in practice - Food Safety - European Commission

With the support and close co-operation of the EU countries, the European Commission has been promoting animal welfare for over 40 years gradually improving the lives of farm animals. An important step in 1998 was Council Directive 98/58/EC on the protection of animals kept for farming purposes which gave general rules for the protection of animals of all species kept for the production of food, wool, skin or fur or for other farming purposes, including fish, reptiles or amphibians.

In March 2018, the Commission designated a first Reference Centre focusing on the welfare of pigs (Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2018/329). This centre aims at improving the enforcement of the EU legislation on pigs, including their transport and killing operation.

EU animal welfare laws cover four key areas - there are 17 laws relevant to farm animals, 11 laws for wildlife, eight laws covering animals used in research, and four laws about companion animals; Current EU law, known as the Lisbon Treaty (a binding agreement between EU member countries), recognises animals as sentient beings, this means they're understood as having the capacity to feel pain and suffering
