Recommendations for Writing Comments on Student Papers

Grading and commenting on papers are certainly interconnected processes. However, while instructors often think of writing comments on papers as simply a means to justify grades, that purpose should be secondary to helping your students improve their writing skills. Make your key contribution here; put a grade and only minimal comments on the final paper. Use peer review (see "Using Peer Review") Working Through the Pile . Review criteria before grading : Know exactly what you expect of an A paper, and how you will differentiate among A, B, C, D, and F papers (see below for suggestions).

Grading Written Assignments

To grade a paper, start by reading it without marking it up to see if it has a clear thesis supported by solid evidence. Then, go back through and write comments, criticism, and questions in the margins. Make sure to give specific feedback, such as "What do you mean by 'some societies?'" instead of something like "What?"

Be sure to use simple, quick markings, and be consistent with them. For example, I don't make big Xs by or circle wrong answers, I just draw a slash through the problem numbers. Try not to make more work for yourself. I once knew a teacher who wrote the correct answers next to wrong ones on EVERY student paper.

Drawing Connections Between the "Big Picture" and the Details: One common approach to commenting on student work is to offer praise, criticism, and questions in the margins of a paper, and then to provide a more general overview of what the paper does well and what it does poorly in a head note or end note. Ideally, this method should allow students to understand not only what the paper's strengths and weaknesses are, but also where specific examples of these occur in the text.

Use your comments to teach rather than to justify your grade, focusing on what you'd most like students to address in future work. Link your comments and feedback to the goals for an assignment. Comment primarily on patterns — representative strengths and weaknesses. Avoid over-commenting or "picking apart" students' work.

The grading process is a team effort, with at least two industry professionals examining every note. Create a checklist of everything you are grading. Your checklist will look similar to a rubric because you will include a list of everything that you want your students to do in the paper. For example, you can have a section for anything you are checking such as content, writing style, mechanics, formatting, etc.

Are your comments specific, accurate, and helpful? Always have at least one more positive comment than you have negative ones. Also, you should have no more than 3 focus areas for each student, so you don't overwhelm them.
