Mountain bike sizing: What size mountain bike do I need ...

How are mountain bikes sized? Mountain bikes are usually sized in inches, or using a S/M/L system. An MTB's frame size is traditionally calculated by measuring the length of the seat tube, from the centre of the front chainring to the top of the tube (where the seat post inserts).

When you ride a bike that fits, you get more comfort and better control. You may be used to choosing a bike size based on standover height or seat tube length. While those measurements are still worth considering, it's more important to look at the Reach and Effective Top Tube measurements when comparing mountain bike sizes.

What size mountain bike is best for me? | Trek Bikes (GB)

Stems longer than 60mm have no place on a mountain bike in 2018. Anyone who says they like a long stem is just on a bike that's too short for them and the long stem is a sticking plaster 'cure'. Far better to be on a bike with a sufficiently long reach in the first place. Mountain bikes ideally should have stems between 30mm and 50mm in length.

What mountain bike frame size should I ride? - MBR

As you can see from the chart, mountain bike frames are measured in inches. Sizing goes from about 13-15 inches, which is what someone on the small size might ride, up to 23 inches and above, which is best-suited to a taller rider.

What You Should Know About Mountain Bike Sizing and Fit

Road bike sizing and mountain bike sizes are slightly different and the units used in bike sizes vary depending on type and brand. Road bike sizes are usually given in centimetres, while mountain bike frame sizes are quoted in inches. Fortunately, our bike size chart takes away the guesswork as it suggests mountain bike frame size and road bike frame size in either inches or centimetres alongside manufacturers bike size charts.

Mountains bikes now come in three different wheel sizes. You can find them with 26" wheels, 27.5" wheels, or 29" wheels. If all three have a 15" frame, there will be a height difference between them due to their wheel size. Bike frames are measured from the middle of their bottom bracket to the end of their seat tube.

For mountain bikes we recommend a distance of 2-4 inches and for road or hybrid bikes 1-2 inches of clearance is required. This will ensure comfort when you're stopped and standing astride the bike.

For road bikes and hybrid bikes, 1 to 2 inches of clearance is, for a mountain bike, you need 2 to 4 inches. The sizes recommend in the sizing charts do take stand over height into consideration. If you've got a close to average inside leg measurement our size chart recommendations will be fine.
