Although the concept of One Health is not new-the theory was supported by William Osler and Rudolf Virchow, the Father of Comparative Pathology, and re-articulated in Calvin Schwabe's 'Veterinary Medicine and Human Health' 6 in 1984-our increasing interdependence with animals and their products has spurred the medical and veterinarian professions to readdress such an approach.

Although the term "One Health" is fairly new, the concept has long been recognized both nationally and globally. Since the 1800s, scientists have noted the similarity in disease processes among animals and humans, but human and animal medicine were practiced separately until the 20th century.
