Translating " Queer Theory " into Russian | UCL School of ... Queer theory attempts to break down the continual use of categories and labels that stereotype and harm those who are in marginalized positions, such as lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (LGBT) people (de Lauretis, 1991).

Advances in Developing Human Feminist Theory and Queer Queer theory challenges the traditionally held assumptions that there is a binary divide between gay and heterosexual, and suggests that sexual identity is more fluid. An example of the fluidity of gender/sexuality can be seen in the character of Captain Jack Sparrow in Pirates of the Caribbean.

Queer theory - SlideShare Queer theory scholars have developed theories which suggest that gender is fluid, flexible and subject to change. Judith Butler ' s work is key to this understanding. She argues that gender is performative – meaning that the performance of gender is what makes gender exist (Butler, 2002). People bring gender into being through gender acts.
