Augustus based the Roman Imperial coinage on the aureus at 1/42nd of a pound of gold, which was equivalent to 25 silver denarii, which in turn was equivalent to 16 copper asses. Within this framework, the bronze sestertius was valued at 4 asses and the brass dupondius at 2 asses. The monetary system of Augustus formed the basis of the coinage for two centuries.

AUGUSTUS COINS. Augustus, the first Roman emperor, was born on the 23rd of September, B.C. 63, and was the son of C. Octavus by Atia, a daughter of Julia, the sister of C. Julius Caesar. His original name was C. Octavius, and, after his adoption by his great-uncle, C. Julius Caesar Octavianus, but for the sake of brevity we shall call him Augustus, though this was only a title given him by the senate and the people in B.C. 27, to express their veneration for him.
