Remember the looser the roots, the taller and healthier your plant will be. When the plant becomes root bound its growth will slow. At that point it is time for a larger pot.

Sugarcane or sugar cane refer to several species and hybrids of tall perennial grass in the genus *Saccharum*, tribe *Andropogoneae*, that are used for sugar production. The plants are two to six metres (six to twenty feet) tall with stout, jointed, fibrous stalks that are rich in sucrose, which accumulates in the stalk internodes.

Sugar cane can only be planted on grass, dirt, podzol, and sand blocks. The block must be directly adjacent to water and not merely above or diagonal as with crops. If a plant's water source is removed, it will break when it is next updated. In Bedrock Edition, the sugar cane is updated with its water, so it breaks immediately.

Sugar cane must be planted on a grass block, dirt, coarse dirt, podzol, sand, or red sand that is directly adjacent to water, waterlogged block, or frosted ice (not merely above or diagonal to water), or on top of another sugar cane block.

Sugarcane needs to be placed next to water. It also does not grow any faster on sand or on dirt. So, I would recommend dirt because it ' s cheaper and because you don ' t need to place a block under it. Sand is more expensive and requires you to place a block under it for the sand to stay up.
