Check the pool and equipment periodically for cleanliness and good maintenance. Cover all sharp edges and protruding bolts; repair rickety or broken ladders and railings. Replace non-slip materials when they wear out. Teach children to float or swim as soon as possible. Always provide competent adult supervision when the pool is in use.

How to Create a Safer Home Pool or Hot Tub. Secure Your Pool When Not in Use. Completely surround your pool with four-sided isolation fencing with a self-closing and self-latching gate that is out of the reach of a child. A four-sided isolation fence (separating the pool area from the house and yard) reduces a child's risk of drowning 83% compared to three-sided property-line fencing.

1) As a pool owner, you should be trained in CPR (Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation). 2) Never let children swim without supervision, even for a moment. 3) As described above, do not allow children to dive from the wall or diving board without proper supervision.
