Fungi under the spotlight. Honey fungus also remained the most prominent garden disease – as it has done since the ranking's inception in 1995. However, it dropped from 26% of enquiries in 2019 to 18% in 2019. Increased rainfall in the summer of 2019 compared with 2018 meant that plants were less likely to suffer from drought stress – which can be the final blow to plants that have lost a lot of their root system to honey fungus infection.

The common earwig can be a nuisance in the garden, damaging the petals of flowers such as dahlias, clematis, delphiniums, pansies and chrysanthemums. However, earwigs do also have a beneficial role in the garden, feeding on aphids and other small insect pests, including the apple codling moth. Symptoms: Large ragged holes in flower petals.

Aphids are as much of a pest in the fall as they are in spring and summer. They're sap suckers who cause damage and grow in numbers quickly. Like most sapsuckers, they excrete honeydew, which attracts ants, wasps, and causes issues like sooty mold. Use organic sprays like neem oil and pyrethrum.

Common plant diseases
Powdery mildew (pictured above)
Problem: White powder on leaves, stems and buds.
Diagnosis: 'Powdery mildew' is a common problem on many plants; a result of fungal disease caused by the plant being dry at the roots with damp air around the top of the plant.

Dealing with common plant diseases (with pictures) - Saga

Crown gall rot (class Alphaproteobacteria: family Rhizobiaceae)
Agrobacterium rhizogenes – This disease is characterised by large lumps at the base of the plant stem or on roots. Galls may appear higher on stems as the disease progresses. Galls are soft compared to surrounding plant tissues. The pathogenic bacteria enter the plant via a wound. If the disease affects the plant whilst it is young the plant may be affected to the degree where it will not produce blooms.
